## Purpose of the REOPEN Committee

The Commissioner required each school system to create a Reopen Committee to publish a comprehensive REOPEN plan with proper safety precautions in the time of COVID-19. The CTSDE published "Adapt, Advance, Achieve: Connecticut's Plan to Learn and Grow Together", an "LEA REOPEN Template", and a "District Survey" to use as a planning tools with July 24, 2020 as the due date for a state review.
